

## What are the Changes for 1 July 2024

## 1. Fee Changes

- Registration for dogs and cats is now required to be paid at 12 weeks of age or upon an animals first transfer. An additional fee payment is necessary in cases where an owner does not desex their dog by 6 months of age or an annual permit is required for a cat not desexed by the relevant age of 4 months.
- Effective July 1, 2024, fee changes will be implemented to meet with legislative requirements. The revised fees will include updates and CPI increases in the following categories: registration fees, permit fees, and additional fees (a new addition). Late fees for these categories will also experience increases.

# 2. Additional Fees

- Annual permits were introduced in July 2020 for dangerous and restricted dogs and for cats that were not desexed by 4 months of age.
- In a move to implement existing legislation requirements, starting from July 1, 2024, the register will support the payment of a dog's registration fee by the age of 12 weeks or upon its first transfer. An additional fee will be due at 6 months if the owner does not desex their dog by that age.
- The CAR will provide three new functions to support the management of additional fees. Depending on the role will depend on the access to a function.

## **New Menu Options**



## **New Site Messaging**

#### **Assisting Councils with Additional Fee Requirements**






- With the changes to align registration with the legislation, registration will be charged at 12 weeks. If not desexed by 6 months (for a dog), an **additional** fee is due.
- Messaging has been added across the site to assist councils and registration agents in determining the requirement to pay an additional fee.
- Additional fee message will display for a dog that has the requirement to pay an additional fees for not being desexed by relevant age. It provides relevant information such as registration due dates, the date the additional fee was date due and indicates if a late fee applies.
- Inclusion of messaging and additional fee receipt details changes have been added to and appear on Identification and Registration certificates, animal search and also in summary areas and will appear with registration information

This is particularly important for older animals where both the registration and additional fee are due at the same time come the 1 July 2024.

#### A) PAYING THE ADDITIONAL FEE - WITH REGISTRATION

Paying the registration and additional fee simultaneously is carried out in the same manner as usual, through the Animal Registration Only or Animal Identification and Registration functions.
 Simply select the combined Dog-Registration

including Additional fee registration type.

## B) PAYING THE ADDITIONAL FEE - AFTER REGISTRATION

When paying the additional fee registration, utilise the "Animal Registration - Apply Additional Fee" menu option. Councils should select the fee type, enter the receipt number, and click "Next." Upon completion, a certificate will be generated at the end of the process, which includes the additional fee receipt.

Late fees still apply to both the registration and the additional fee after 28 days

Initially owners will not be able to pay the additional fee through the online eRegister, with this feature planned for release later in 2024. Until that time, the additional fee will need to be paid at council.



#### Removing an additional fee



#### Steps to Remove an Additional Fee



#### **Additional Fee Summary**

- The removal of an Additional fee is accessible to Council Level 3 users only, and it can only be executed for additional fees that were applied by your council.
- Removal of an additional fee is only permissible in the following cases:
  - Incorrect application (e.g., data entry errors, dishonoured payments, duplicate fees).
  - Special circumstances with prior approval from the council.
- Only the council that issued the additional fee has the authority to remove it.
- The Additional Fee will record a refund and show up in a new Additional Fee Financial report.

## **Animal Registration – Additional Fee Exemptions**



Applying for an additional fee exemption

#### In what cases can an exemption be requested for an owner?

The ability to apply for an additional fee exemption is available by request to the Office of Local Government (OLG).

Additional fee exemptions are applied on a case-by-case basis in the following circumstances:

- Dog was desexed late prior to 1 July 2020 must be now desexed (eg Vet) or the date of birth is unknown.
- Dog is an interstate animal now residing in NSW and not registered in NSW until recently.
- Owner unable to register in time due to online and council limiting services.
- Dog released from a rehoming organisation and not desexed where the exemption existed.
- Request by Council Details of request must be supplied.

Careful consideration is taken for requested exemptions.

Please note an exemption cannot be applied to dangerous or restricted dogs.

# 4. Correcting Registrations


- There will be 2 main features in the Correction of registration function from 1 July 2024.
- The introduction of Additional fees means that a registration cannot be removed until the additional fee has first been removed for cases where it has been paid after registration.
- Support for council to change a registration paid online for an animal kept as a breeding animal.
- With the change for the registration requirement to be paid at 12 weeks, there will be cases where a breeder decides to keep their animal as a breeding animal and the registration type will need to be changed to reflect that. Council will be able to carry this out for a breeder.



#### **Breeder support at Council - Enabling Councils**

Breeder Support – what to do when a breeder has chosen to retain their animal for recognised breeding purposes after paying registration at 12 weeks.





#### Overview

Please note that registrations issued through the **online Pet eRegister** cannot be corrected or removed at council, except in cases where a breeder has chosen to retain their animal for recognised breeding purposes.

In such instances the following applies:

- The original registration must be a standard 12-week registration type or breeder registration type. Both are allowed in case council make an error and need to set it back to the original registration.
- the registration must be modified to the breeder registration type of equivalent value.
- whilst council now can have the ability to change this for online eRegister registrations the receipt will remain with the originating council.
- the registration cannot be removed, and the button is disabled.
- If there is any variation in the amount council must reach out to Companion Animals

#### <u>Message - Registrations made on the online eRegister</u>

Message will display indicating that council can make this change for a registration paid online.

- Menu options will now become available.
  - Click on Correct or Remove a Registration
- To support this change the Registration type drop down will have a only registration types for standard and breeder registrations, for the given species that are available from 1 July 2024
- All key registration details will remain the same.
- All corrections will be logged with the user and will appear in the transaction search

OLG will continue to have full ability to correct any registration for any council



#### New forms design and new fields

The new **Permanent identification P1A** forms now contains two new fields.

- Mother Microchip Number
- Breeder Identification Number (BIN)
- These fields have been introduced in the CAR and will support the capture of data and display of data.
- The display of these fields has been integrated alongside existing authorised identifier information across the site, including on certificates.
- Populating these fields is restricted to the Identification or Identification and Registration functions.





## **Animal Identification - Prefill from Litter (NEW)**

Identification Process From a Litter - Prefill animal information from data previously populated by a breeder and/or vet



#### What is the purpose of this function?

Primary purpose of this function is to streamline the Identification process for animals created online from litters where vets or identifiers have not completed the identification themselves during microchipping.

Whilst every attempt is being made to provide education, this scenario may still occur.

This function has been introduced to reduce the intensity of data entry process for councils and improve the data quality in the process.

#### When should I use this?

If the Identification form provides the following four fields and the date of birth is after 1 July 2018 then you can use this function.

- Date of Birth ( Date of Litter)
- Mothers Microchip Number
- Breeder Identification Number (BIN)
- Authorised Identifier Number


Please note: If you do not have the date of birth and Mothers Microchip or Bin Number, or if your animal's date of birth is prior to 1 July 2018, then please use the Animal Identification function to complete the process

PART 1/2 – SEARCH AND DISPLAY LITTER DETAILS

#### Step 1 – Search for your Litter

- 1. Click on Animal identification- Prefill from Litter menu option.
- 2. Enter:
  - Animal's Birth Date -
  - Mother's Microchip Number and/or
  - Breeder's Identification Number
- 3. Implanter Code is optional and used to populate the offspring identification screen. It is valuable when identifying multiple offspring from the one litter
- > To search Click 'OK'

4. If the litter exists on the register, then the litter will display under litter search result. Click on 'View & Identify Offspring' to complete the identification process From the Litter and Offspring – Complete Identification



- 1. Enter:
  - Microchip Number
  - Implanter Code
  - Implant Date
- Click Update and Link

#### Step 3 – Print a Certificate

- After the Offspring is identified a tick will appear in the Linked and Identified fields for that offspring.
- Click Print a Certificate

#### Step 1 – Identify an offspring Step 2 – What happens Next?

- Validation Checks
- The microchip will be checked to see if the microchip already has been entered on the register
- already has been linked to an offspring in a litter
- If the Implant dates ,primary breed, gender and are correct
- Implanter Code is valid
- **Validation Passes**
- If there are no errors, then the animal will be linked and the screen will indicate that this process is now complete.
- 3) Validation Fails
- If any of the validation above fails
- The offspring will NOT be linked or identified(created)
- an error message will appear

#### Step 4 - Check Details and Change Details if necessary

Check that the animals' details on the identification form is the same as the certificate. If they differ then click on change details and go into this function to make further changes.

#### Why is this important for councils to know?

- Informing councils when a user has an online account and has a linked pet to their profile will ensure that council can handle the online user effectively.
- Once users have an online account, contact and address details should be managed as part of Service NSW update of profile to ensure accurate and up to date information is pushed to all your pet accounts and the owner can be contacted in the case of an animal goes missing.
- In some instances, it may be a case that the owner doesn't know how to login so goes to council. Council can confirm with the owner and ensure that in the case of their pet(s) being lost their contact details and access to online is available.

#### Where does the message show?

- Change of details, Animal Registration, Animal Search
- A message has also been added to the Animal Search to help manage owners and their needs.

**Level 3** – Removal of Accounts linked to an owner is not yet possible online.

This safeguard is to ensure that an animals' details is removed correctly and considers any other linked records such as litters and offspring that may exist. Requests can be made to OLG to complete this task.

#### Remove Animal Record

An animal cannot be deleted where:

- It is linked to a litter.
- linked to an online owner
- Is a mother of a litter
